SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Infant/Child Baptism: Baptism is our incorporation into the Body of Christ and the foundation of our sacramental life. Contact Ana Valencia at the parish center to begin the process of instruction and celebration.

Children's Penance/Eucharist/Confirmation: Preparation for these sacraments of initiation are handled within our Faith Formation program. For questions, contact Ana Valencia.

Adult Initiation: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the path for those seeking to learn more and perhaps ask for full initiation into the Catholic church. A related process is available for those adults who only need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. For initial questions, contact any clergy person of the parish.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Penance: this Sacrament is celebrated Saturday from 4:00-4:30 PM in the Church. Other times are available by making an appointment with parish priests.

Anointing of the Sick: freely offered to those who are sick, facing surgery, those with chronic mental or emotional illness, and those of advanced age. In the Covid-19 era, there are certain conditions that prevent clergy from home visits and hospitals, but contact Fr. Blicharski at the parish if you would like the sacrament and we can determine if we can celebrate it safely.

SACRAMENTS OF SERVICE

Christian Marriage: Congratulations and blessings on your engagement. Every couple has unique gifts and needs, and our clergy will walk and work with you to meet our own time-tested standards to get you to the altar and beyond. Contact anyone on the pastoral team.

Holy Orders: If you are sensing God's call to service as a priest or deacon in the church, contact our pastor and/or any parish team member you feel can best serve you.

Similarly, even though there are no sacraments associated with the religious life, monastic life, lay ministry or faith-based humanitarian service, please contact us if we can help you in your discernment.

THROUGH AT LEAST SEPTEMBER 2021...

Due to COVID-19 realities, all non-parish-wide activities (i.e., groups) are suspended for the foreseeable future.

COVID-19 FURTHER CHURCH RESTRICTIONS

On February 22, Governor Murphy raised the capacity limits for houses of worship to up to 50%, if 6-foot distancing can be maintained. We are working on determining our new raised limit.

We have added a 6:00 PM Sunday Spanish evening Mass to provide an added safe option for worship and to increase weekend capacity.

Those in vulnerable groups should stay home, and those who are sick or symptomatic must stay home. Catholics in our diocese will continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass until further notice.

PARISH OFFICE CLOSED UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2021

As near-misses and second-level exposures to the coronavirus increase among parish staff and leaders, **the parish center is again closed to the public.** The parish team will use this time to reconfigure the entrance area to have a safer degree of encounter with parishioners when we do open again. Staff is continuing to work remotely and in the office and can be reached by phone or email.

Lenten SACRIFICE

So that the Church of Metuchen may be spiritually one in a common observance of Lent, the following days of fast and abstinence are to be observed by all Catholics of the Diocese who enjoy the blessings of good health:

1. The days of fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
2. All other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence.
3. From the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday until the celebration of the Easter Vigil on the evening of Holy Saturday, the Easter fast should be observed so that, with uplifted and welcoming hearts, we may be ready to celebrate the joys of the Resurrection.

This ancient tradition, intimately connected with the Rites of Holy Week and the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is encouraged, especially in those places baptizing catechumens at the Easter Vigil.

The obligation to fast applies only to Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. To fast in the Catholic tradition means to limit oneself to one full meal during the day so as to experience hunger.

The obligation of abstinence affects all Catholics who have reached the age of 14. Abstinence in the Catholic tradition means to abstain from meat.

The obligation of fast and abstinence, as a whole, is a serious obligation. While failure to observe any penitential day in itself may not be considered serious, the failure to observe any penitential days at all, or a substantial number of them without good cause, would be considered a grave matter. Those unable to abstain for a valid reason on any given Friday of Lent are asked to perform some other penitential act, or to abstain on another day.

RCIA If you or someone you know would like to hear more about Jesus and His church, we invite you to join us at an Inquiry Session. In addition, if you wish to be baptized into the Catholic Faith, you are already baptized and wish to receive the other Sacraments of Initiation, or you come to us from another faith wishing to become a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church, then we invite you to join RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). REFLEXIÓN

"Él respondió Aquí estoy!" - Genesis 22:11

Es fácil decir, "Aquí estoy, Señor" cuando nos arrodillamos en la iglesia, pero ¿qué tan fácil es decir "aquí estoy Señor" cuando un vecino necesita nuestra ayuda, cuando somos invitados a unirnos a un ministerio en la parroquia, o cuando se nos pide ayuda financiera? A menudo somos llamados cuando no es conveniente para nosotros. El discipulado no siempre es fácil, la mayor parte del tiempo nos va a hacer sentir incómodos y vulnerables.

AÑO DE SAINT JOSEPH

En la parroquia, nuestro Año de San José correrá hasta el festival de clausura el 1 de mayo de 2022. Cada mes tendrá un tema contemplativo y un tema de acción asociados.

Para febrero de 2022: El tema contemplativo es: **Ocultación (Mateo 6:6)**. Y el tema de acción es: **Limosna y ayuno**.

La enseñanza evangélica de Jesús que se proclama el Miércoles de Ceniza nos aconseja "ir a tu habitación interior, cerrar la puerta y orar a tu Padre en secreto." Mientras nos preparamos para entrar en una segunda Cuaresma seguida en algún tipo de bloqueo de pandemia, ¿cómo podemos aprender de las oportunidades obtenidas y desperdiciadas el año pasado durante el primer encierro? ¿Dónde está esa habitación interior? ¿Qué estamos haciendo allí?" Durante los años ocultos en Nazaret, Jesús aprendió en la escuela de José a hacer la voluntad del Padre." (Papa Francisco, Patris Corde, diciembre de 2020.) ¿Cómo estamos aprendiendo a hacer la voluntad del Padre?

Nuestro tema de acción parroquial Año de San José para febrero es La limosna y el Ayuno. Ahora es el momento de reflexionar sobre las acciones concretas de Cuaresma en el ámbito de la limosna y el ayuno. La campaña Plato de Arroz de Catholic Relief Services es nuestro único proyecto de limosna en toda la parroquia, pero no tiene por qué limitarse a eso. También hay muchos aspectos del ayuno más allá de las pocas restricciones dietéticas que la iglesia recomienda durante la Cuaresma.
