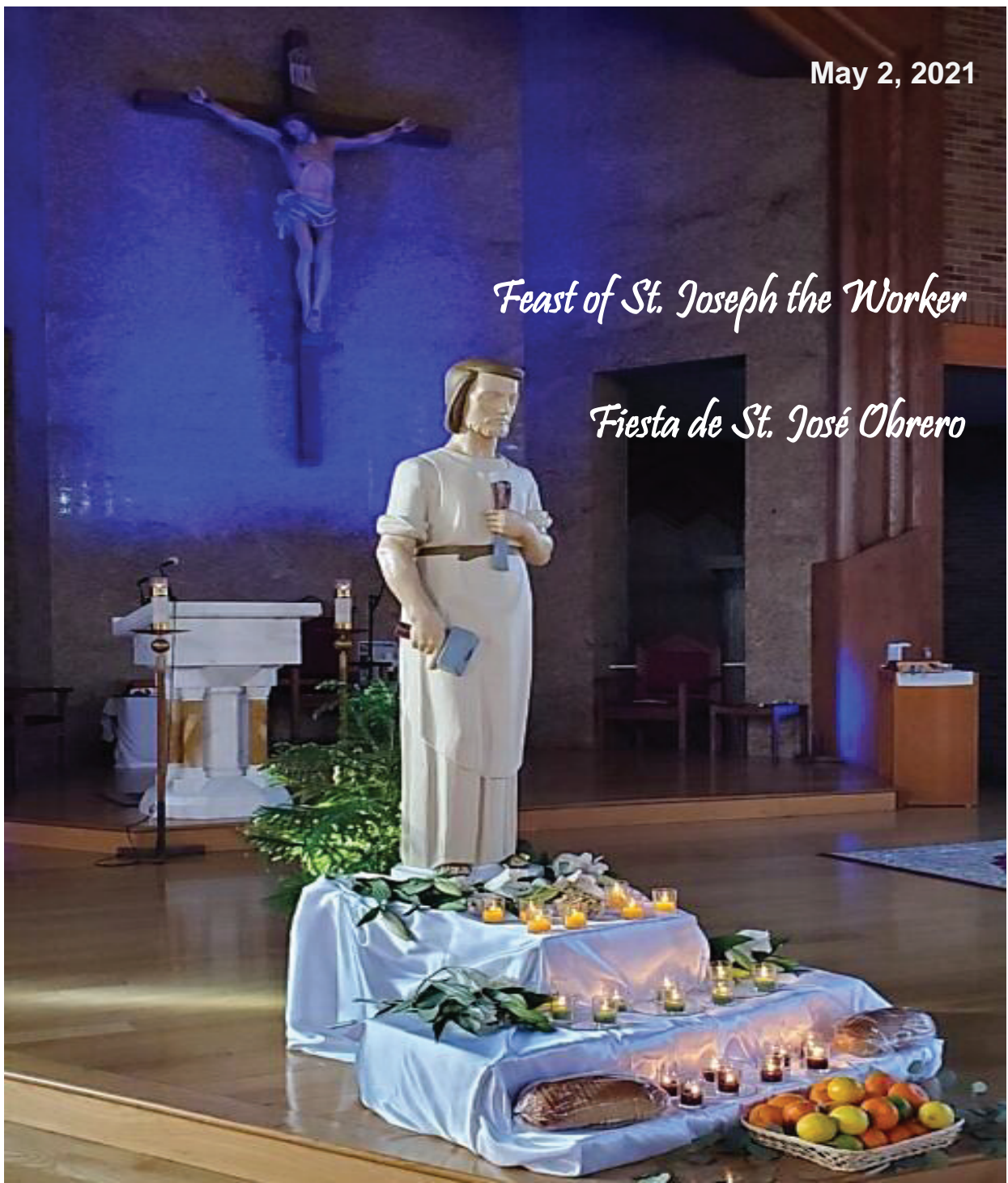

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Infant/Child Baptism: Baptism is our incorporation into the Body of Christ and the foundation of our sacramental life. Contact Ana Valencia at the parish center to begin the process of instruction and celebration.

**Children's Penance/Eucharist/
Confirmation:** Preparation for these sacraments of initiation are handled within our Faith Formation program. For questions, contact Ana Valencia.

Adult Initiation: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the path for those seeking to learn more and perhaps ask for full initiation into the Catholic church.

A related process is available for those adults who only need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. For initial questions, contact any clergy person of the parish.

CHRISTIAN MARRIAGE

Congratulations and blessings on your engagement. Every couple has unique gifts and needs, and our clergy will walk and work with you to meet our own time-tested standards to get you to the altar and beyond. Contact anyone on the pastoral team.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Freely offered to those who are sick, facing surgery, those with chronic mental or emotional illness, and those of advanced age. In the COVID-19 era, there are certain conditions that prevent clergy from home visits and hospitals, but contact Fr. Blicharski at the parish if you would like the sacrament and we can determine if we can celebrate it safely.

THROUGH AT LEAST SEPTEMBER 2021...

Due to COVID-19 realities, all non-parish-wide activities (i.e., groups) are suspended for the foreseeable future.

COVID-19 FURTHER CHURCH RESTRICTIONS

On February 22, Governor Murphy raised the capacity limits for houses of worship to up to 50%, if 6-foot distancing can be maintained. The new raised capacity of the church is now 163 people.

We have added a 6:00 PM Sunday Spanish evening Mass to provide an added safe option for worship and to increase weekend capacity.

Those in vulnerable groups should stay home, and those who are sick or symptomatic must stay home. Catholics in our diocese will continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass until further notice.

PARISH OFFICE CLOSED UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2021

As near-misses and second-level exposures to the coronavirus increase among parish staff and leaders, **the parish center is again closed to the public.** Staff is continuing to work remotely and in the office and can be reached by phone or email.

NEW: The Church Community Room opens each Tuesday evening 6:30-8:30 PM for pastoral services with one or two staff members present.

As the year of St. Joseph continues at the parish, we have these additions:

- 1) Starting this weekend, at the end of the Universal Prayer at each Sunday Mass for the duration of the year, we will pray the prayer to St. Joseph that concludes Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter *Patris Corde*:
*Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
To you God entrusted his only Son;
in you Mary placed her trust;
with you Christ became man.
Blessed Joseph, to us too,
show yourself a father
and guide us in the path of life.
Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage,
and defend us from every evil. Amen.*
- 2) When there is no liturgical event taking precedence, we will pray the Votive Mass for St. Joseph on Fridays for the rest of the Year of St. Joseph.
- 3) Our parish contemplative theme for May in the year of St. Joseph is: **Manual Labor**. And our justice theme is **Worker Justice**. On Tuesday, May 25, the pastor's chapter talk will cover these themes.

MAY INTENTIONS OF OUR HOLY FATHER

We unite with Pope Francis, for this universal intention during May: **The World of Finance**. May those in charge of finance will work with governments to regulate the financial sphere and protect citizens from its dangers.

NJ BISHOPS DECIDE TO MOVE ASCENSION THURSDAY

The Newark Province of Bishops, which includes the Diocese of Metuchen, agreed to move the Solemnity of the Ascension from its usual Thursday slot 40 days after Easter to the following Sunday, for this year only. Thus, Ascension will be celebrated on Sunday, May 16 this year, and our regular daily Mass schedule will be in effect for Thursday, May 13.

BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL NEARS GOAL

Our phenomenal response to the Bishop's Annual Appeal continues, as we close in on the goal of **\$33,000**.

In statistics released by the Diocese of Metuchen on April 26, the Development Office has received pledges totaling \$27,897.50 and payments totaling \$23,995.00 from 92 parishioners. This represents 84.5% of our \$33,000.00 goal. Thank you for your efforts!

We've scheduled two "in-pew" weekends with parishioner-speakers who work closely with the diocese, **May 23 and June 20**. It will give all parishioners a chance to make impromptu cash contributions, and, at this pace, however, those talks might simply be "thank-you" talks as we take a victory lap for another generous season of support. We will hear from parishioners who are intricately involved in diocesan life: Deacon Edgar Chaves, Hispanic Ministry officer, Luz Helena Escobar and seminarian Flavio Rojas. We will pass the hat (lightly) after their talks.

NEXT LEVEL PROJECT: PARISH UPDATE

Our NeXt Level parish teens, mentors, parents, pastor and staff coordinator joined with their counterparts in the 12 other selected parishes in the New York City-New Jersey region April 24 for a retreat at Forest Lodge in Warren.



During the weekend of May 15-16, a survey will be available at all Masses for parishioners to weigh in on what may be the most pressing needs in charity and justice for the parish and wider community.

Special Pentecost Vigil Mass and Solemn Pentecost Sunday Vespers to close the season.

The special **bilingual Pentecost Vigil Mass on May 22 will be at 8:00 PM** and replace the 7:00 PM Spanish Mass. (5:00 PM English Mass remains.)

There will be multiple readings, with special prayer and reflection responses after each reading. Four adults will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. We will introduce the role of adult altar servers and bring back lectors for this special Vigil Mass.

On **Pentecost Sunday, May 23, our 6:00 PM Mass will have Solemn Vespers** integrated into the Mass. At the conclusion of the Mass, the Paschal Candle will be placed in the narthex for the remainder of the liturgical year until next Easter. Songs of praise will accompany this movement.

GUÍA DE MISAS PUBLICAS

El 22 de febrero, el Gobernador Murphy elevó la capacidad límites para las casas de culto hasta el 50%, si 6 pies de distanciamiento se pueden mantener.
