BISHOP'S APPEAL STATUS

As of July 12, the Development Office has received pledges totaling \$38,460.50 and payments totaling \$36,766.75 from 180 parishioners. This represents 116.5% of our \$33,000.00 goal. Thank you for your efforts!

LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

As for the reinstatement of **liturgical ministries**, our activation plan has no connection now to COVID-19, but rather the implementation of a comprehensive pastoral plan that will stretch over the coming months. Former or aspiring liturgical ministers will be asked to join an application process, formation and training. **All former ministers must re-apply if they desire to have post-pandemic service.** This will take place over the summer months, should the pandemic numbers continue to lend themselves to safer environments. We are creating a new concept of what liturgical service means at St. Joseph Parish, with new requirements, responsibilities and opportunities. The future form of sacred music liturgical ministry will follow a related path, in consultation with the parish music director.

COMING IN 2022: NEW FAMILY FAITH FORMATION

The year of Religious Education instruction has concluded. We plan to launch a new family-centered Faith Formation model in 2022, and it will be a continuous model, no longer connected to the school year. Parents will be the primary catechists, and families will attend the monthly sessions **as a family**. There will be both age-appropriate instruction as well as plenary presentations and family activities. Stay tuned for further information. There will be no registration or other activity for the remainder of 2021, as we continue to develop the new model.
