## PARISH PRIORITIES

### DELTA VARIANT COVID-19 UPDATE

As the Delta variant of COVID-19 courses through the country and New Jersey, we are exceedingly grateful for parishioner response in continuing to respect the situation and one another by following our seating arrangements, care with Communion practice and overall good cheer during an extended time of difficulty.

We continue to carefully watch the variant spread, and what that may mean for us, in consultation with our COVID-19 emergency management consultant and further guidance from the State of New Jersey and/or the Diocese of Metuchen. We continue to encourage stragglers to get vaccinated, mask up in the special social distance section of the church, avoid congregating indoors either before or after the Mass, and generally to be mindful of the immediate transmission possibilities in your spatial awareness.

Recently we have had a couple of interactions with churchgoers blatantly defying our very flexible seating guidelines by refusing to mask up in the special "mask and social distance" section, and then not to move when asked. These attendees disrespect our clergy and ministers who have confronted them.

**If you are in the social distance section and do not want to wear a mask, please move to the open seating or leave.**

### GROWING OUR PARISH SPIRITUALITIES

This summer we are deepening our practices in these areas and inviting more to participate, by dedicating a weeknight per practice.

**Wednesdays** (morning and evening): contemplative chants at the daily Masses. Lectio Divina practiced 10 minutes before the 7:00 PM Mass.

**Thursdays**: one decade of the Divine Mercy chaplet recited during the 7pm Mass; whole chaplet recited after Mass as part of a weekly gathering of devotees.

**Fridays** (every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday evening): 7pm Mass with a charismatic theme. Meeting of participants in the charismatic movement follows the Mass every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday.

Masses celebrated in front of the church (weather permitting) to foster fellowship and enjoy God's creation. Celebrated the first Monday of the month, July through October. ### COMING IN 2022: NEW FAMILY FAITH FORMATION
