DELTA VARIANT COVID-19 UPDATE – AUGUST 10

As the Delta variant of COVID-19 courses through the country and New Jersey, we are very grateful for parishioner response in continuing to respect the situation and one another by following our seating arrangements, care with Communion practice and overall good cheer during an extended time of difficulty. *We strongly encourage everyone to get vaccinated and observe safe hygienic practices. Though we are not mandating mask use church-wide again, we strongly encourage it.*

Our "Masked & Distanced" section saw a large increase in attendance at our recent two Sunday Masses so. We will watch this overall situation closely as it is likely to be worse over the next 2-3 weeks. We are ready to designate the small, behind-the-choir section as a "Masked & Distanced" section, and take other steps. In response to recent developments, effective immediately:

- Church doors will be open during popular Masses.
- The 5:00 PM Saturday vigil, 7:00 PM Spanish vigil and 6:00 PM bilingual Sunday Mass will now be hymnal-free, and thus safer Masses for those concerned about congregational singing.
- If you are in the "Masked and Distanced" section and do not want to wear a mask, please move to the open seating or leave.
- Have a heightened awareness of your distance and potential exposure time in any proximity to others.

ATTENTION LEAF-BLOWER AND LAWN-RAKING PARISHIONERS IN BOUND BROOK

You have permission to "leave the leaves alone" this year, from the National Wildlife Federation: Leaves are starting to change color and begin to fall to the ground. Did you know that leaving the leaves in your yard or garden not only saves you time and energy but also benefits wildlife? Here are a few good reasons to put down the rake:

- **Many wildlife species use the leaf layer as their primary habitat:** salamanders, chipmunks, wood frogs, box turtles, toads, shrews, earthworms, millipedes, and thousands of insect species.
- **Provide food for wildlife:** creatures like earthworms and millipedes reside in and decompose leaf litter, and also are themselves a source of food for bigger wildlife like birds and toads.
- **Increase fertility of your soil:** as the leaves decompose, nutrients are added to your soil, and also allows for greater water retention. At St. Joseph Catholic Community, we will therefore NOT be raking or blowing leaves on our grass areas, unless they are causing a trip hazard on the walkways. This is not neglect or laziness; we are actively cultivating a vibrant soil substrate for our church property and for our wildlife friends.
