

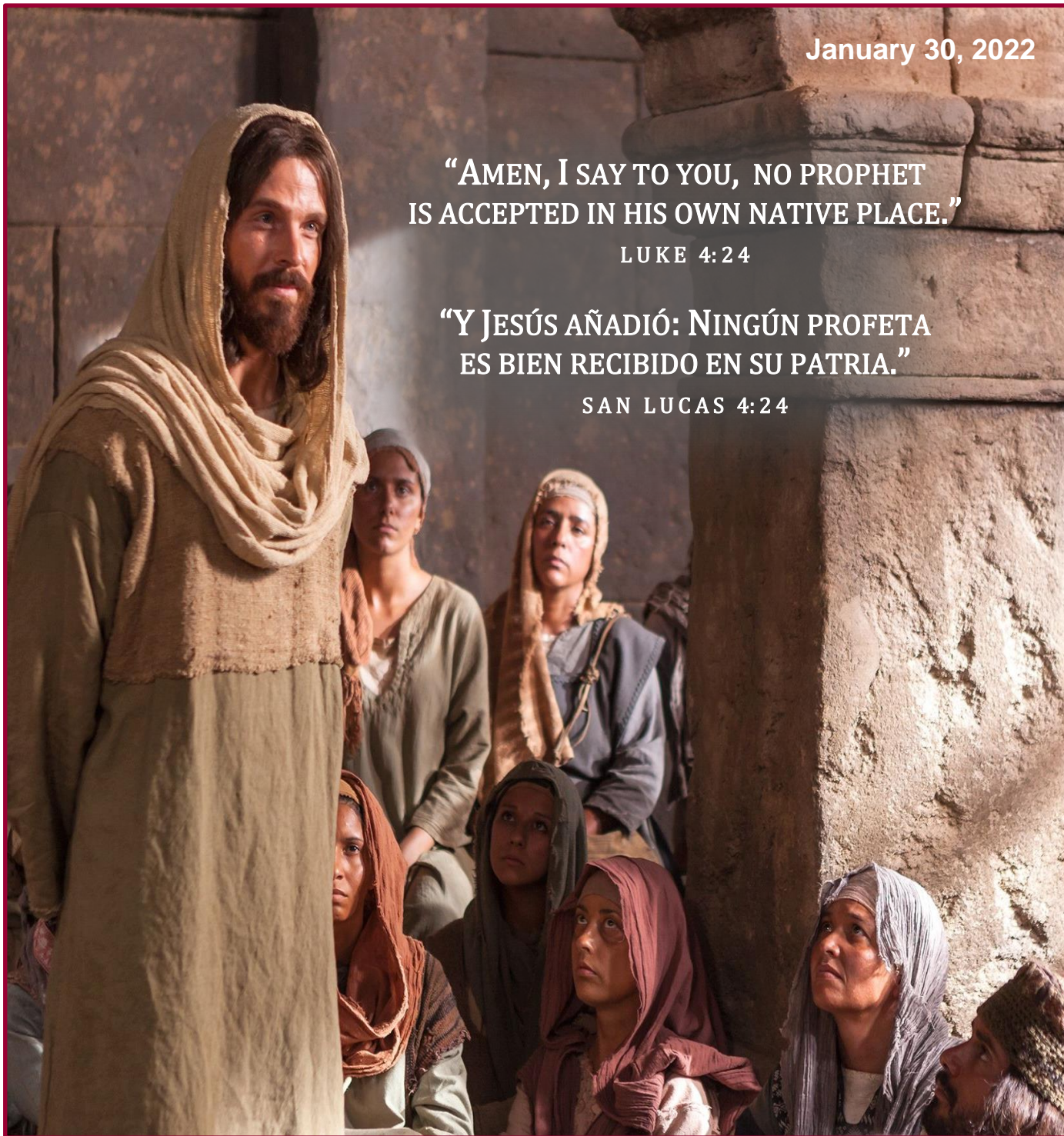

PRAYER INTENTION OF THE HOLY FATHER, POPE FRANCIS, FOR FEBRUARY 2022

For religious sisters and consecrated women

We pray for religious sisters and consecrated women; thanking them for their mission and their courage; may they continue to find new responses to the challenges of our times.

WOMEN'S JUSTICE CIRCLE

We are happy to announce that a parishioner from one of our long-time families, **Valeria Morales**, will be leading a new project at the parish, a Women's Justice Circle. Valeria recently completed her MSW at Rutgers University and did field placement at the Caritas program in New Brunswick, among her accomplishments. She is also currently part of the NeXt Level project here at the parish.

Women's Justice Circles originated in the Pacific Northwest as an empowerment tool for low-income communities. Often, communities served by Catholic religious sisters in that part of the country were the ones identified to have groups.

Because a justice circle best originates in a group of 6-8 people, we are hopeful that we can have Valeria begin to form a group as soon as the omicron surge begins to crest. The circle will meet for several sessions, and then communally decide on a project that can benefit a wider circle. So, there's great potential. Valeria has met virtually with the founder of the Circles in Washington state and has the necessary resources to begin. I also have experience with Women's Justice Circles from my time with the Catholic Campaign for Human Development.

More information will be available soon, and if you see Valeria around, please welcome her aboard for the duration of the project.

CATHOLIC SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION – DRIVERS NEEDED

A shortage of bus drivers and the pandemic have combined to create a limit on the number of students on buses, due to the distance required for student seating. The capacity for buses has been cut by almost 50%, thus creating a situation by which private contractors can no longer transport many nonpublic school students for the \$1,000 per-pupil amount because of the fewer number of students on a route. The Bound Brook Presbyterian Church (BBPC) is serving as the interim host for a community food pantry previously operated by the Bound Brook School District at the LaMonte School. This pantry will eventually move to the Methodist Church on Union Avenue, once flooding-associated repairs are completed. During the interim period, the pantry will be held in the PFC gym every Sunday from 1:00 PM - 2:30 PM. You can help by volunteering to work at the market.
