### CONTEMPLATIVE SCHEDULE

The church is open Monday through Friday at 6pm for contemplative practice. Monday is always reserved for the Lectio Divina practice. On the first Monday of each month, we have an "explained" Lectio Divina, where newcomers can better understand the process better. Our next explained Lectio Divina is this coming Monday, June 6, using the Gospel for Trinity Sunday.

### STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

*"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (JOHN 14:26)*

The materialism of our society lures us to concentrate more on what we want than on what God wants for us. The relativism of our world tells us that we should be tolerant of all things, that there is no absolute truth. Pray to the Holy Spirit to transform our lives and to guide our thoughts, words and actions. What you put in your head, heart and mind affects your actions. Put good things in and good things will come out.

### BOUND BROOK INTERFAITH CIRCLE

Thanks to all from St. Joseph who attended the Bound Brook Interfaith prayer service on May 27 in light of the mass shootings in the United States.

Our local clergy group is planning a six-week series of Sunday afternoon events in October-November, starting with a prayer walk in town, and also a short Bible study series and a Thanksgiving service with a theme of food insecurity.

### PENTECOST

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations.



**As a parish, after our Pentecost Masses, we formally end the 50 days of Easter with a special bilingual Vespers service Sunday, June 5 at 6:00 PM. Join us for this 30-minute service.**

Pentecost is also a Jewish holiday, which Jews use to celebrate the end of Passover. Jews celebrate the gift of the law to Moses at Mt. Sinai on this day. But we, as Catholics celebrate the birth of our Church.

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. Jews from all over the world were gathered with Peter, the leader of the Apostles and the Eleven. At this time, a great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon these people and each began to speak in tongues. Despite the fact many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another. Others who were not so blessed, accused those speaking in tongues of being drunk, but Peter arose and addressed the crowd, explaining that it was only 9 o'clock, and that this phenomenon was not intoxication, but rather this was the work of the Holy Spirit, prophesized in the scripture. Peter then called all those present to be baptized and about three thousand people were baptized that day. These people were among the first Catholics, and Peter is the first pope of the Catholic Church.

On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given, and communicated as a divine person: of his fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance.

On that day, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity. By his coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the "last days," the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated.

Ana will live as a monk for a little more than a month and learn from a wide range of guest speakers at Mepkin, in the hopes of designing new projects for those not affiliated with religion in our area but hoping to go deeper in prayer.

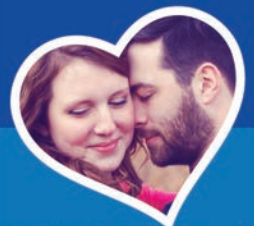
