

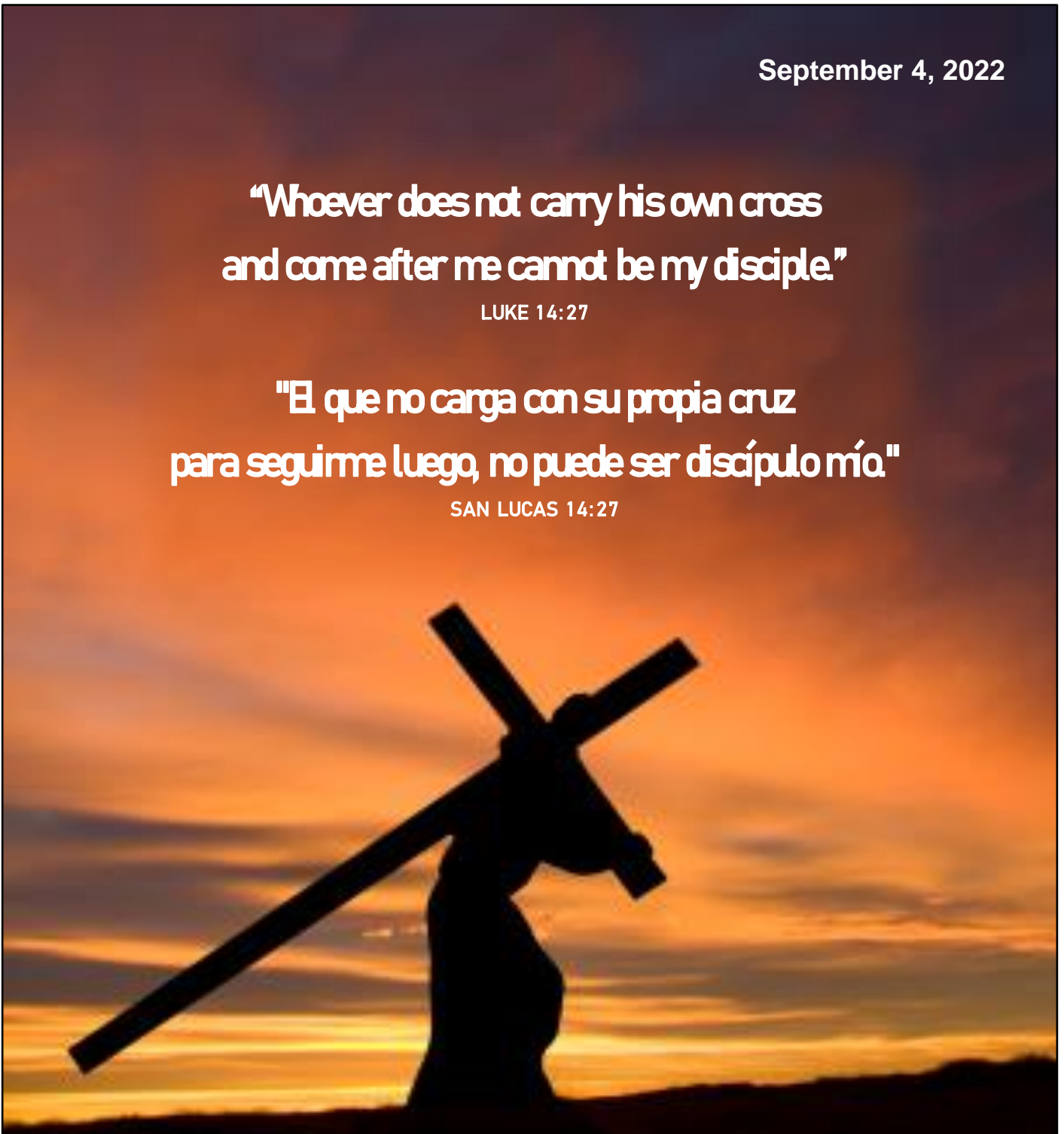

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Infant/Child Baptism: Baptism is our incorporation into the Body of Christ and the foundation of our sacramental life. Contact Ana Valencia at the parish center to begin the process of instruction and celebration.

Children's Penance/Eucharist/Confirmation: Preparation for these sacraments of initiation are handled within our Faith Formation program. For questions, contact Ana Valencia.

Adult Initiation: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the path for those seeking to learn more and perhaps ask for full initiation into the Catholic church.

A related process is available for those adults who only need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. For initial questions, contact any clergy person of the parish.

PRAYER INTENTION OF THE HOLY FATHER, POPE FRANCIS, FOR SEPTEMBER 2022:

Abolition of the Death Penalty

We pray that the death penalty, which attacks the dignity of the human person, may be legally abolished in every country.

Pope Francis' new encyclical, "Fratelli Tutti," does something that some Catholics believed could not be done: It ratifies a change in church teaching. In this case, on the death penalty.

In 2018, Pope Francis ordered a change in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, the official compendium of church teaching, when he termed the death penalty "inadmissible." Today the pope placed the full weight of his teaching authority behind this statement: The death penalty is inadmissible, and Catholics should work for its abolition. A papal encyclical is one of the highest of all documents in terms of its authority, removing any lingering doubt about the church's belief.

MARY ELLEN KIRCHMAN STEPS DOWN

On our Catholic calendar, Sept. 15 is the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows, and here at St. Joseph, we will have our own very personal cause for sorrow that day. After nearly nine years of sterling pastoral service at the parish, **Mary Ellen Kirchman** is stepping down from her role as Office Manager.

Mary Ellen brought a graceful and skilled presence to our parish office after successful previous stints in a large hospital system and in the World Trade Center. She served as a constant, gracious and welcoming initial point of contact for parishioners, vendors and others while three pastors have led St. Joseph during the same span. She has kept the office rolling through these transitions, and especially during the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent relocation of the parish office to its current site at the church.

Mary Ellen is discerning her next career move, and we wish her, her husband Kevin and children the very best. There will be three events at the parish honoring and thanking Mary Ellen: a private event for the parish team, a parish-wide reception on **Saturday, September 10 after the 5:00 PM Mass**, and a breakfast reception following the **daily 8:30 AM Mass on Wednesday, September 14**. All parishioners are welcome to the latter two gatherings.

SEASON OF CREATION

SEPTEMBER 1 - OCTOBER 4

What is the "Season of Creation?" [From LaudatoSi Movement.org](#): "Season of Creation is a time of grace that the Church, in ecumenical dialogue, offers to humanity to renew its relationship with the Creator and with creation, through celebration, conversion and commitment together."



In other words, the Season of Creation is the annual ecumenical celebration of prayer and action for our common home.

The Season of Creation begins on September 1, World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and ends on October 4, the feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology beloved by many Christian denominations.

Individuals and communities are invited to participate through prayer, sustainability projects and advocacy.

- Prayer: Host an ecumenical prayer gathering that unites all Christians for the care of our common home.
- Sustainability: Lead a cleanup project that helps all of creation thrive.
- Advocacy: Raise your voice for climate justice by participating in or leading an ongoing campaign, such as the fossil fuel divestment movement.

In 1989 Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitros I proclaimed September 1 as the Orthodox Day of Prayer for Creation. Subsequently, the World Council of Churches (WCC) extended the celebration until October 4, the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi. In turn, in 2015 Pope Francis made the Season of Creation official for the Roman Catholic Church.

In this regard, Pope Francis expressed in 2015: *"The annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation will offer individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live. The celebration of this Day, on the same date as the Orthodox Church, will be a valuable opportunity to bear witness to our growing communion with our Orthodox brothers and sisters."*
